### TIPS (From Popular Photography Column)

- 1) **Older eyes-Require reading glasses** to see the small  
menus on your LCD screen – buy a cheap pair of 2X magni-  
fying glasses and pop out the right lens. Use left eye for the  
LCD and camera controls and right eye for the viewfinder.
- 2) During cold weather when camera batteries go fast, wrap  
spare batteries in the inexpensive hand warmers sold in  
sporting goods stores, and switch batteries as soon as you  
notice a slowdown. Works for faster write times for memory  
cards in cold weather too.
