## **JUNE ASSIGNED SUBJECT**

### **Definition of "Pictorial Landscape"**

To represent or illustrate with a picture, a presentation of a view or visual image of: (1) natural inland scenery; (2) a portion of territory that can be viewed at one time from one place; (3) a particular area of activity. A depiction of such scenery may also, as opposed to "nature" pictures, include the hand of man, persons and/or animals, as long as they are of minor importance to the picture and not the main focus.

## **PRINT EXHIBITIONS**

**Our next Print Exhibition will be at Westminster City Hall in September. Call for entries will begin in July.**

**Each participant will be able to enter 4-5 prints, to be determined by the number participating. Prints must be framed with glass and hanging wire, no sawtooth, and there will be a charge of \$2.50 for each entry to cover food for the reception and ribbons as this will be a juried show.**

**Price entries to cover a 10% fee for any prints sold. Prints must be marked on the back with the maker's name, phone number, title of print and selling price.**

**The prints will be on display for the entire month of September. Makers will be responsible for delivering their prints to Westminster at 8:00 a.m. on Thursday morning, September 1st. (Date may vary) and we will be asking for help in hanging the prints.**

**We have exhibited prints before at Westminster and some prints have been sold each time.**
