Prints must be framed with glass, & a maximum size of 20"x 24", including frame. *Prints will be due by Friday, May 26th, 5 p.m. at the gallery at 3947 Tennyson Street, Denver.*

Prints must have your name and phone number, title of print and price on back of each print. Prints must be matted and framed in a professional manner and of interesting content. Jan may reject prints she feels do not meet this criteria.'

There will be two divisions – Monochrome & Color Prints Ribbons will be awarded to 1st, 2nd & 3rd Place winners and for 1st & 2nd Place for Creative Prints in each division. The show will be judged by outside judge(s).

Prints will need to be picked up between June 17st & 24th. Gallery Hours are: Tues-Wed 10-7, Thur-Fri 9-5 & Sat 10-2 pm.

There will be a charge of \$7 per entry, to be paid to Jan, and if you have at least one entry to be hung, you can enter mounted prints to be displayed in bins, 11x14 min & 16x20 max size for a fee of \$1/each. No commission will be taken on any sales.

Number of prints accepted from each member to be determined upon getting a final count of those participating. Probably will be a total of 4-5 prints.

The club will be responsible for submitting a final listing to Jan of each person's print title and price. When final entries are determined, this information must be given to Dee or Larry.
