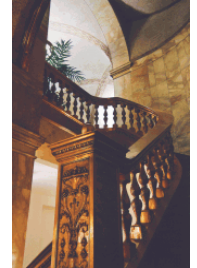

This workshop translates photographic language and practices from traditional to digital and exposes you to a world of new possibilities. You’ll see, use, and evaluate the latest Epson printers, ink, papers, and profiles. An integrated approach to using Adobe products Photoshop, Camera Raw, Bridge, and Lightroom will all be detailed and practiced. You will master a fine art workflow, understand how it differs from others, and learn a variety of techniques and tools that will help improve and refine both your digital files and prints. You will leave with finished prints and the knowledge to get the results you’re looking for when you return home, plus a vastly expanded set of possibilities for making images.
